We shall begin in the 16th century with Alvar Cabeza de Vaca's "The Relation of Alvar Nunez Cabeza de Vaca" and we shall conclude in the 21st century with Toni Morrison's God Help the Child. Our texts include non-fiction, fiction, poetry and drama. Aside from the generic and rhetorical material, we shall engage with psychoanalytical, feminist, and reader-response/reception theory in relation to the texts. As well, the course introduces students to the skills for conducting research and writing critically.
