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Course description:

This course provides students with the fundamentals of modern standard Korean in basic conversational and grammatical patterns, assuming that the students have no or little previous background knowledge of Korean. The objective of the course is to equip students with basic spoken and written communicative skills in the interpersonal mode in essential daily life situations.

The course materials will be provided on Moodle for each lesson of the textbook. Typically, each lesson will be covered within two weeks. Students will study the lecture videos prior to the weekly Zoom meeting and will participate in diverse activities during the online class meetings, which will be once a week for about 50 minutes.
