Course description:

The objective of the course is for students to develop communicative skills in speaking, reading, and writing at the intermediate level in Korean. This includes expressing various stances of the speaker--e.g., judgment, inference, and evaluation or subjective assessment of ideas--and expressing more complex relations between events, such as cause, reason, purpose, condition, concession, intention and background. Students are expected to develop a lengthy narrative discourse on personal experience.

Organization of the course:

The course materials will be provided on Moodle for each lesson of the textbook. Typically, each lesson will be covered within two weeks. Students will study the lecture videos prior to the weekly Zoom meeting and will participate in diverse activities during the online class meetings, which will be once a week for about 50 minutes.
