GER 2000 – Intermediate German

Course Description

German 2000 will expand students' knowledge of German language and culture. All four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) will be further developed through exposure to different authentic text types of the German-speaking world. You will learn and use more advanced grammatical structures, vocabulary and idioms. Some of the grammar learned in German 1000 will also be reviewed.

In person, 2 classes per week (2 hours each class)
