#### Advanced Modern Standard Korean

##### Course Description

This course is designed to equip students with communicative skills in speaking, reading, and writing beyond the advanced level in Korean.

##### Language of Instruction

Korean/English

##### Prerequisite

AP/KOR 2000 or equivalent

##### Course Format and Organization

This in-person course is consisted of lectures and in-class activities. Students will develop competence in fluency, grammatical accuracy and sociolinguistic appropriateness via diverse activities and assignments. In addition, the course will enhance the students' understanding of historical/social/cultural aspects of Korea via various resources such as TV or newspaper commercials, serialized television programming ("drama") clips, picture books, cartoons, songs, movies, etc.
