Course Description

This course examines the visual cultural forms and practices of the two Koreas, the Republic of Korea and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. Students will gain a deeper understanding of the two Korean societies, culture, and history by exploring diverse visual culture genres.

*Course Format and Organization

Each class will consist of group presentations on the readings with discussions, followed by lectures and in-class discussions.
