## Course Delivery

Delivery Mode: LECT

The course is delivered in-person. It consists of weekly lectures and tutorials. Active student participation is a key component of the course and is expected during in-class activities. The course also incorporates experiential education opportunities, such as Chinese calligraphy practice and other organized cultural activities, to enhance language learning through hands-on engagement.
