Course Description

This course provides students with the fundamentals of modern standard Korean in basic conversational and grammatical patterns for students who have no or little previous background knowledge of Korean. The objective of the course is to equip students with basic spoken and written communicative skills in the interpersonal mode in essential daily life situations.

Course Delivery

Delivery Mode: in-person

This course is organized into mandatory in-person classes, which students are expected to attend twice a week at the assigned class time; and the self-study assignments and preparations such as preparing for quizzes, practicing for role playing in model dialogue practice tests, and submitting homework assignments.
